FROM THE CURRENT REVISION OF THE HALL OF FAME BYLAWS:

ARTICLE 9. ELIGIBILITY

All Candidates: To be eligible for election to the HALL OF FAME, the following criteria must be met:

1. Superior Performance (Candidate's name is NOT shown on the ballot)
 - A. Must be at least 35 years of age as of the deadline date for nominations,
 - B. Must have been (or must be) an active member of the Decatur USBC* for at least 15 years with an established yearbook average of 21 games or more, AND
 - C. Must have exhibited superior performance in USBC-certified bowling leagues and/or tournaments.

2. Meritorious Service (Candidate's name is NOT shown on the ballot)
 - A. Must be at least 35 years of age as of the deadline date for nominations,
 - B. Must have been (or must be) an active member of the Decatur USBC* for at least 15 years with an established yearbook average of 21 games or more, AND/OR
 - C. Must have demonstrated service, devotion and unselfish contribution of his/her time, above and beyond the ordinary, to the game of bowling for at least 15 years in the Decatur area.

3. Veteran (Candidate's name is NOT shown on the ballot)
 - A. Must be at least 55 years of age as of the deadline date for nominations,
 - B. Must have been (or must be) an active member of the Decatur USBC* for at least 15 years with an established yearbook average of 21 games or more, AND
 - C. Must show one or a combination of the qualities described in 1C or 2C above.

4. In Memoriam (Candidate's name WILL BE shown on the ballot): Eligibility of those who have passed on may include a combination of the above requirements and will be left to the judgment of the Hall of Fame Governing Board.
